

More than 60 years of work and experience

The Higher Education Technical School of Professional Studies in Novi Sad (VTSNS) is a state institution founded in 1959 as the Advanced Mechanical Engineering School.

In the past years, thousands of students have graduated from the School, which is a significant contribution to the educational, social and economic development of the entire region because our students are not just from Serbia. They also come from neighbouring countries due to cultural and historic ties.











Novi Sad, Serbia



The School is situated in the city of Novi Sad, the *European Youth Capital* 2019 and the *European Capital of Culture* 2022 (postponed from 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic). Novi Sad is the main economic and political centre of the Province of Vojvodina, a multinational community where people have learned to respect differences and live together, not side by side. This attitude reflects the policy of the School, as well.








In line with the Bologna Process

Today the School is a leading higher education institution of this type and since 2007, all our study programmes with competence-based curricula have been in compliance with the European educational standards stated in the Bologna Declaration.









Professional studies


The School educates a wide range of professionals for work in industry, starting from mechanical engineering and protection, through graphics to electrical engineering and informatics.

At the moment, we have about 1,800 students at 10 accredited three-year bachelor degree study programmes, two master programmes and one short programme.














Higher education system in Serbia

Our first degree studies (basic professional studies) have 180 ECTS, while the second degree studies (professional master studies) have 120 ECTS.



VTSNS Master programmes


Two-year master programmes following the basic studies with 120 ECTS credits:

Now we have well equipped laboratories for different purposes.

















VTSNS facilities

Ties with industry

Long-term relationships with local and regional businesses are strong and extensive.

Also, we do the following: organise special training courses for employees in industry; develop risk assessment acts, occupational safety and health regulations, and waste management plans; conduct inspection and testing of work equipment and working environment; provide consulting in the quality system certification regarding management, environmental protection, safety and health at work, and integrated systems; commercial printing. 


CEEPUS network

The Central European Exchange Programne for University Studies (CEEPUS), with the central office in Vienna, Austria, is an international exchange programme involving higher education institutions from Central and Eastern Europe and the Balkan Peninsula.

In January 2021 we joined the network **Training and research in environmental chemistry and toxicology** (CIII-SI-0905-07-1921).

Its coordinator is the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Health Sciences, Slovenia, and there are 26 more members from 12 countries. Our activities start from the next academic year.









Bilateral agreements with foreign HEIs


The School has bilateral agreements on cooperation with:




